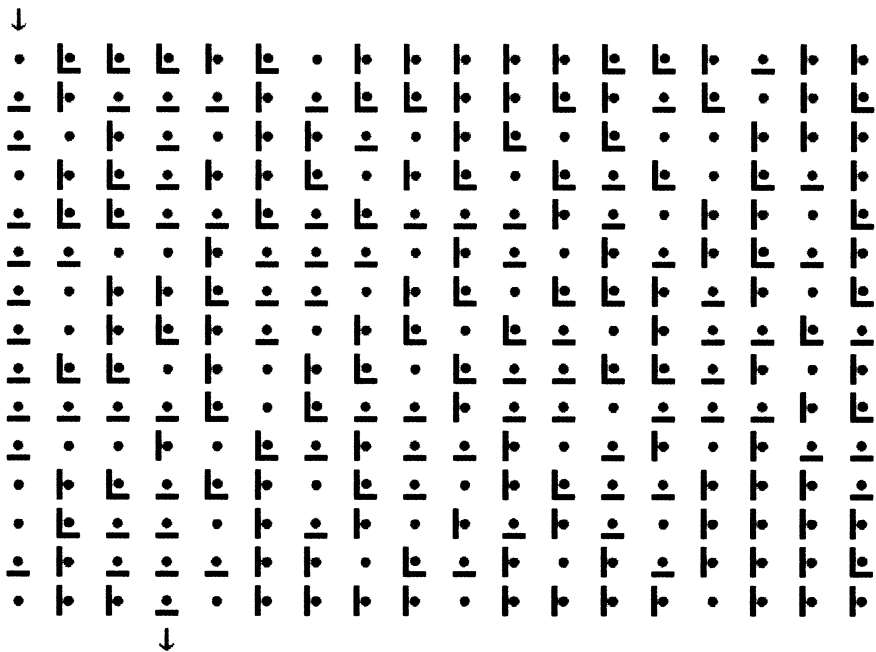

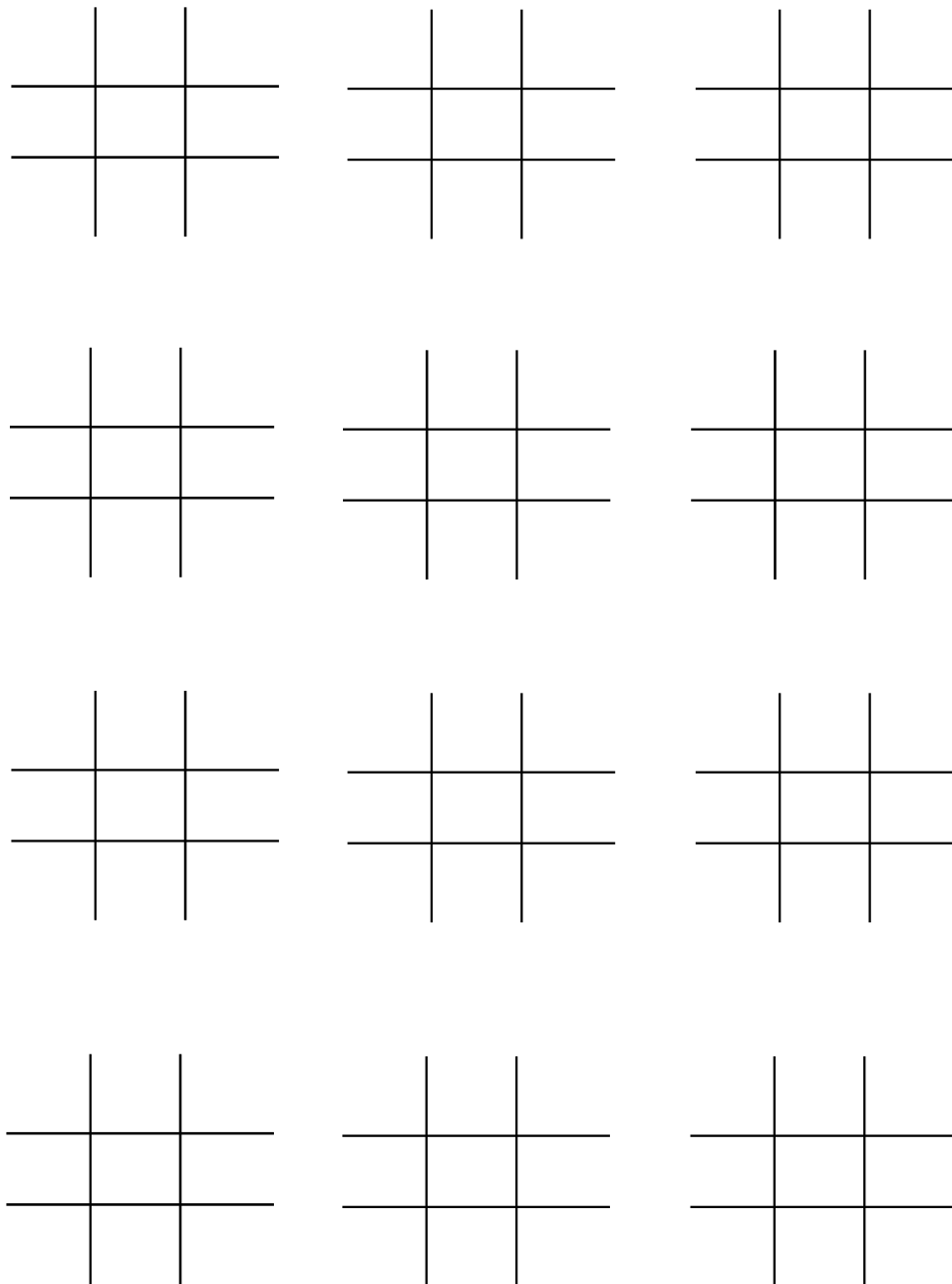

AntiMaze
