It is secure, quick and easy!**

Many donors are using electronic giving as a simple and efficient way of supporting the ministry of St. Paul's Newman Center and many more are inquiring about it. The flexibility built into electronic giving puts the donor in control of the amount, frequency and duration of contributions.

Options include:

- **Credit/Debit Card Giving:** St. Paul's Newman Center can receive credit or debit card donations. Donors can go to our website at www.newmancenter.org and click the **Donate** button on the main page which will quickly and easily assist you donating through [SimpleGive](#).
- **App Donations:** [SimpleGive](#) has an app too! It can be downloaded in your App Store to manage your recurring or single time donations using your credit or debit card.
- **Online Banking:** You can make recurring donations of fixed amounts and/or one-time donations. With Internet banking, you can designate how much each period using your online banking feature, to send donations to St. Paul's Newman Center at 1800 Grand Avenue.
- **Electronic Fund Transfers:** Through this method, you and St. Paul's Newman Center would enter into an agreement where you provide the parish with a bank account number and the amount to be given on a regular basis (5th or 20th of each month.). The Newman Center withdraws the amount from your account each month. Contact aja@newmancenter.org if you are interested in using this method of donating. Set up and changes are quick and simple.
