Mrs. Leon was very pleased. She gave Adam a big hug. She told Adam she could see that God was working through Adam's good deeds. It was a great summer for them all.

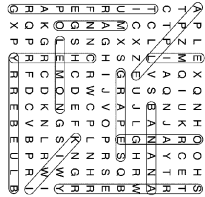

Jesus said he was the vine and we are his branches; what do you think that means?

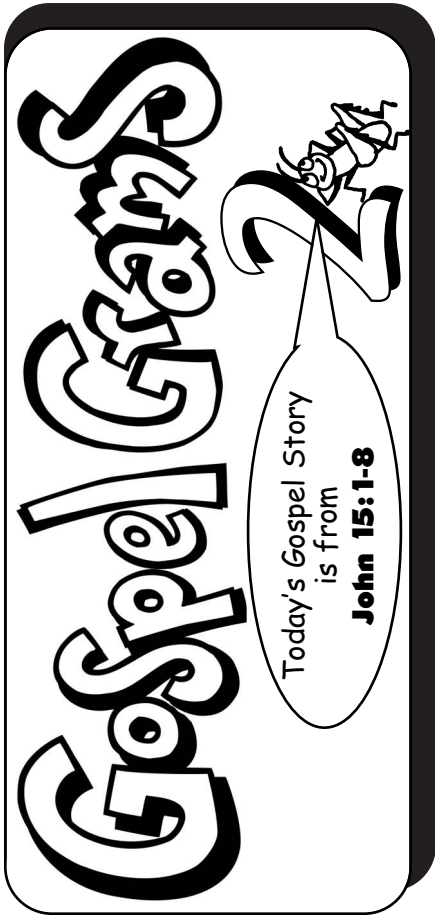
